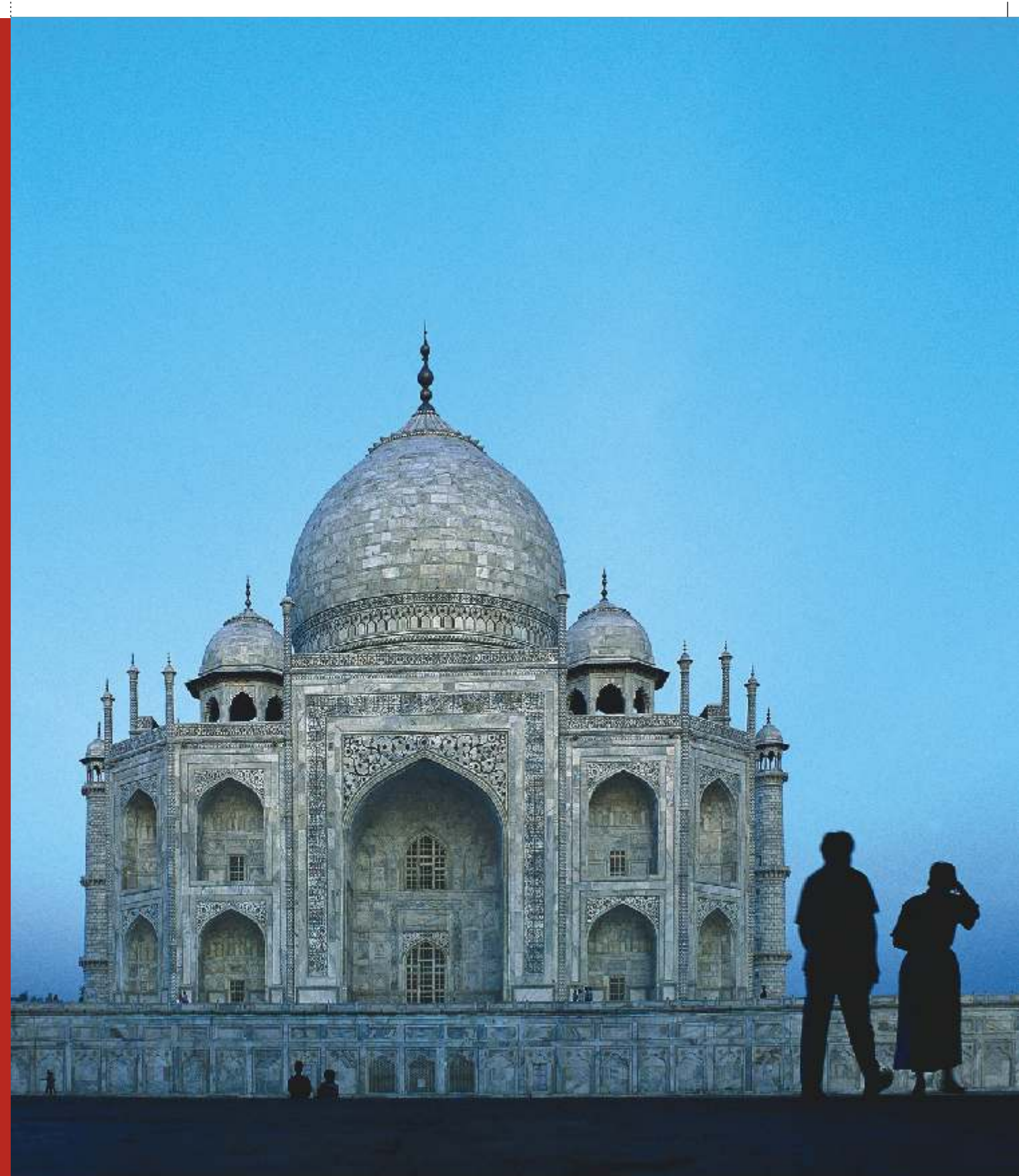

**DAY 1 DELHI** On your arrival at Delhi you will be met and transferred to the hotel by our representative. An afternoon visit to New Delhi includes the Rashtrapati Bhawan, the official residence of the President of India; the India Gate, a memorial raised in honour of Indian soldiers martyred during the Afghan war; the Laxmi Narayan Temple, built by the Birlas, one of India's leading industrial families; Humayun's Tomb, lotus shaped Bahai Temple and Qutub Minar, built by Qutub-ud-din Aibek of the Slave Dynasty. In the evening you can visit see light an sound show at Red fort. Return to the hotel for overnight at the hotel.

**DAY 2 DELHI - AGRA (200 km. 4 Hours)** After breakfast depart for Agra. En route, stop over at Sikandra to see the Tomb of Mughal Emperor Akbar. On arrival at Agra, transfer to the hotel. Later in the day a visit to one of the Seven Wonders of the World Taj Mahal, an architectural wonder will be made. The tour continues with a visit to the Agra Fort, which lies, across the river Jamuna, famous for exceptional views of the Taj from its little octagonal tower. Overnight stay at the hotel.

**DAY 3 AGRA - JAIPUR (240 km. 4 Hours)** After breakfast checkout and drive to Jaipur. On the journey, a visit to a town belonging to the Mughal Dynasty - Fatehpur Sikri will be made. Built in red sandstone, in honour of Saint Salim Chisti, who foretold the birth of 3 sons to Emperor Akbar, Fatehpur Sikri is an example of robust stability combined with originality. Each important edifice here represents a type by itself. Notable among them is the Diwane Khas; Panch Mahal, the Tomb of Salim Chisti himself, and the Buland Darwaza. The journey proceeds to Jaipur. On arrival, transfer to the hotel. The afternoon will be spent on a tour in and around Jaipur: City Palace, in the heart of Jaipur, is known for its blend of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture. Not too far, is the Central Museum. Jantar Mantar is the largest of the five observatories built by Sawai Jai Singh. The Hawa Mahal or the Palace of Winds was constructed for the royal ladies to watch the royal processions without being seen, all monuments are located in the vicinity of City Palace Complex. The evening is kept free for a visit to the famous markets selling textiles, gems, carpets, and handicrafts, making Jaipur an ideal place for buying souvenirs. After dusk a visit to Nahargarh Fort, illuminated over floodlights is a mystical sight. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

**DAY 04 JAIPUR - DELHI (260 km. 5 Hours)** After breakfast check out and later visit Amber Fort, situated just outside the city. Enjoy the experience of rides on elephant back to and fro the top of the hill on which the fort is situated. Later, proceed to Delhi.
